#### **THINGS TO KNOW**

## DRESS CODE FOR TAKING THE PHOTOGRAPH AT REGISTRATION

The head, face and hairline must be seen, therefore **NO** hat, cap, shawl, scarf or any form of covering of the head or face except for religious reasons.

The eyes must be clearly visible, therefore **NO** tinted glasses, shades, cosmetic eye covering or hair is allowed to obscure the eyes.

The shoulders must be covered, therefore **NO** sleeveless shirts, tops or dresses are allowed.

**DO NOT** wear white.

#### **COST OF THE NEW ID CARD**

The first new ID card will be issued free of cost, however, there is a fee of \$60 for all subsequent replacement cards.

### EXPECTED REGISTRATION WAIT TIME

The registration process will take approximately fifteen minutes but the wait time will depend on the number of persons ahead of you to be registered.

## EXPECTED WAIT TIME FOR COLLECTION OF THE NEW CARD

Your Trident card enables Digital ID and requires additional verification and security procedures. The card will be available for collection at the centre at which you were registered approximately six weeks after registration.

## HOW WILL MY TRIDENT CARD MAKE LIFE BETTER?


Barbados is introducing a new National ID which includes your new Trident card and the forthcoming Trident mobile app.

- You may use your Trident card in exactly the same ways that you have always used your old ID card
- In the future, your Trident card will allow you to create a Digital ID which is an electronic representation of your identity in the same way that your ID card is a physical representation of your identity.
- Your Trident card will allow you to prove who you are without being physically present.
- You may choose which features you wish to use and you are always in control of your information.

#### **ONLINE REGISTRATION**

You may also complete the registration process online by visiting **trident.gov.bb**. You will be guided through the steps and allowed to choose the location at which you would like to collect your card. Once the verification process is completed, you will be notified when to collect your card.

#### WHAT IS THE TRIDENT CARD?

Your new Trident card will replace your existing National ID card with a more secure, durable and attractive card.

The Trident card has been designed to be tamper-resistant with a range of visible and invisible security features.

Your new card also has a number of additional features which will make identifying yourself and accessing services easier and faster.

Please take the time to read and become familiar with the process for getting your Trusted Identity with your Trident card.

#### WHEN TO REGISTER?

Registration will be conducted Monday to Friday **9:00am to 5:00pm**; Saturday **9:00am to 4:00pm** 

Persons will be registered by surname in six categories over a two week period for each category:

1. A-B 2. C-F 3. G-K 4. L-R 5. S-Z

6. Incapacitated and Persons in Institutions

Incapacitated persons will be registered at their place of residence if a request is made to the Electoral Office.

Persons in Geriatric Hospitals, Children's Homes, Correctional Centres etc. will be registered at the Institution.

The full schedule of dates will be published shortly.

When registering, adults may register their child(ren) under 16 years, regardless of the child(ren)'s surname.

#### **VALIDATION OF**

#### **REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

The new Barbados National ID Card is being issued in compliance with international standards for identity security and identity management and in compliance with the requirements of the Barbados Identity Management Act and the Barbados Data Privacy Act. It is therefore necessary to validate your registration information, wherever possible this will be done electronically so that you do not have to acquire new documents.

#### **ID CARDS ISSUED AFTER JANUARY 1ST, 2018**

Persons whose ID cards were issued after January 1, 2018 (see issue date at the back of card) are **not** required to present documents, **unless there was a subsequent name change or** (for non-nationals) **a change or extension of residential status.** 

#### **BARBADOS PASSPORT**

A Barbados passport may be presented, even if expired, and no other documents are required unless there was a subsequent name change.

#### **ID CARDS ISSUED BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2018**

For faster receipt of your ID card, persons with ID cards issued before January 1, 2018, who have documents in support of their name, date of birth, nationality and residential status (for non-nationals) **may** present them at registration.

You are requested to present your old ID card as this will reduce the registration time, but you will be allowed to keep it until you collect your new card.
